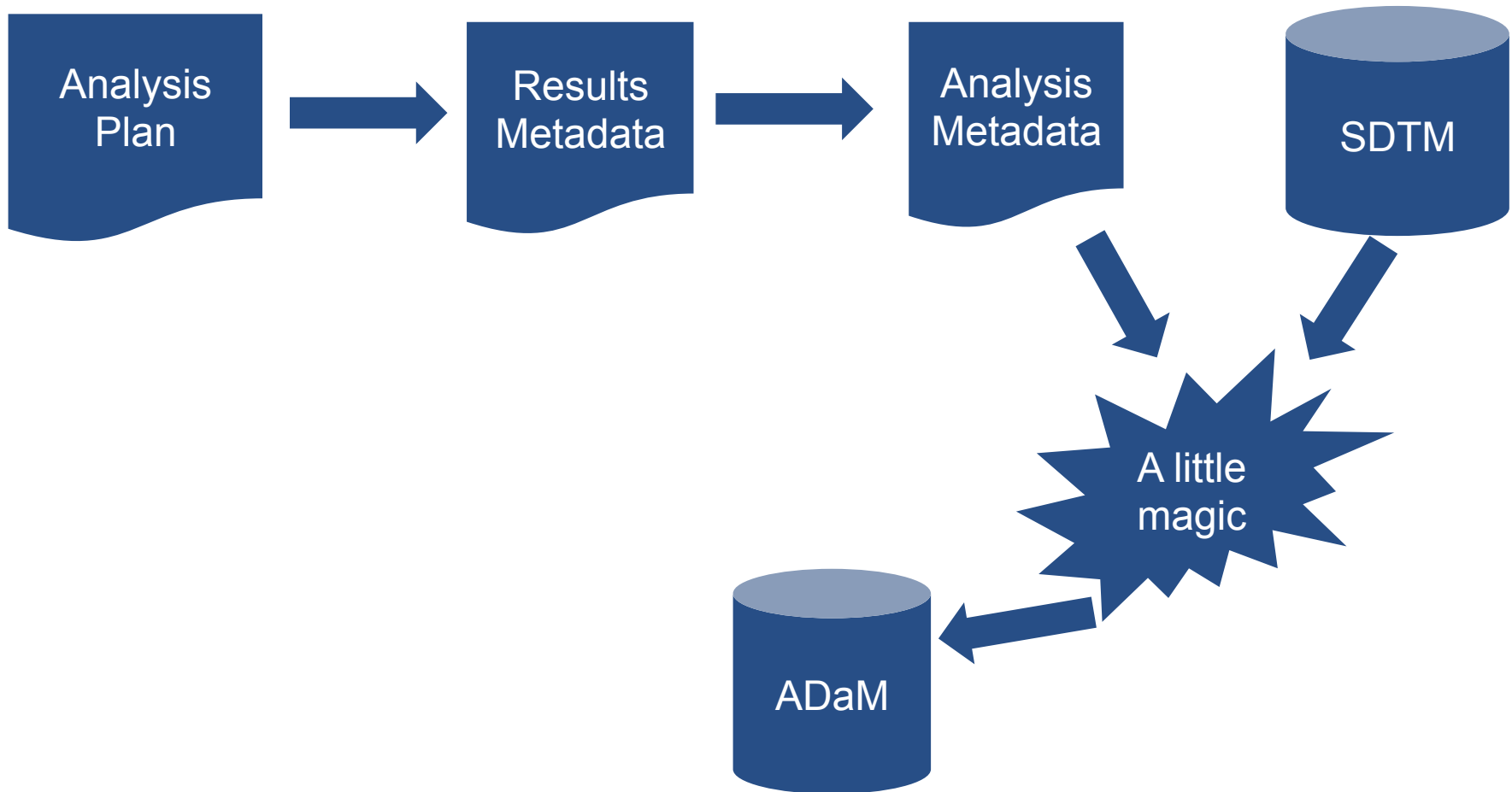

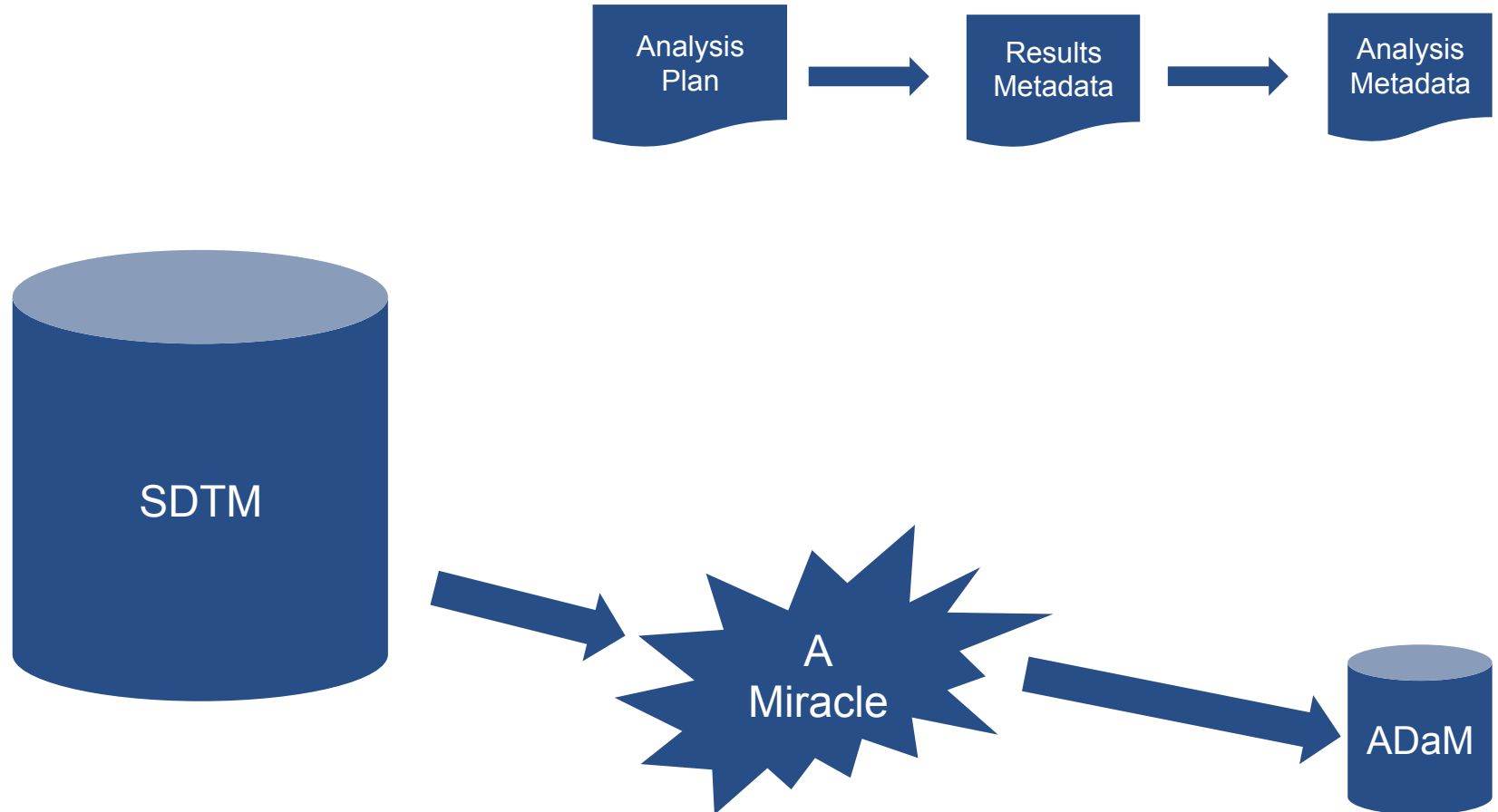


ADaM is such a simple concept



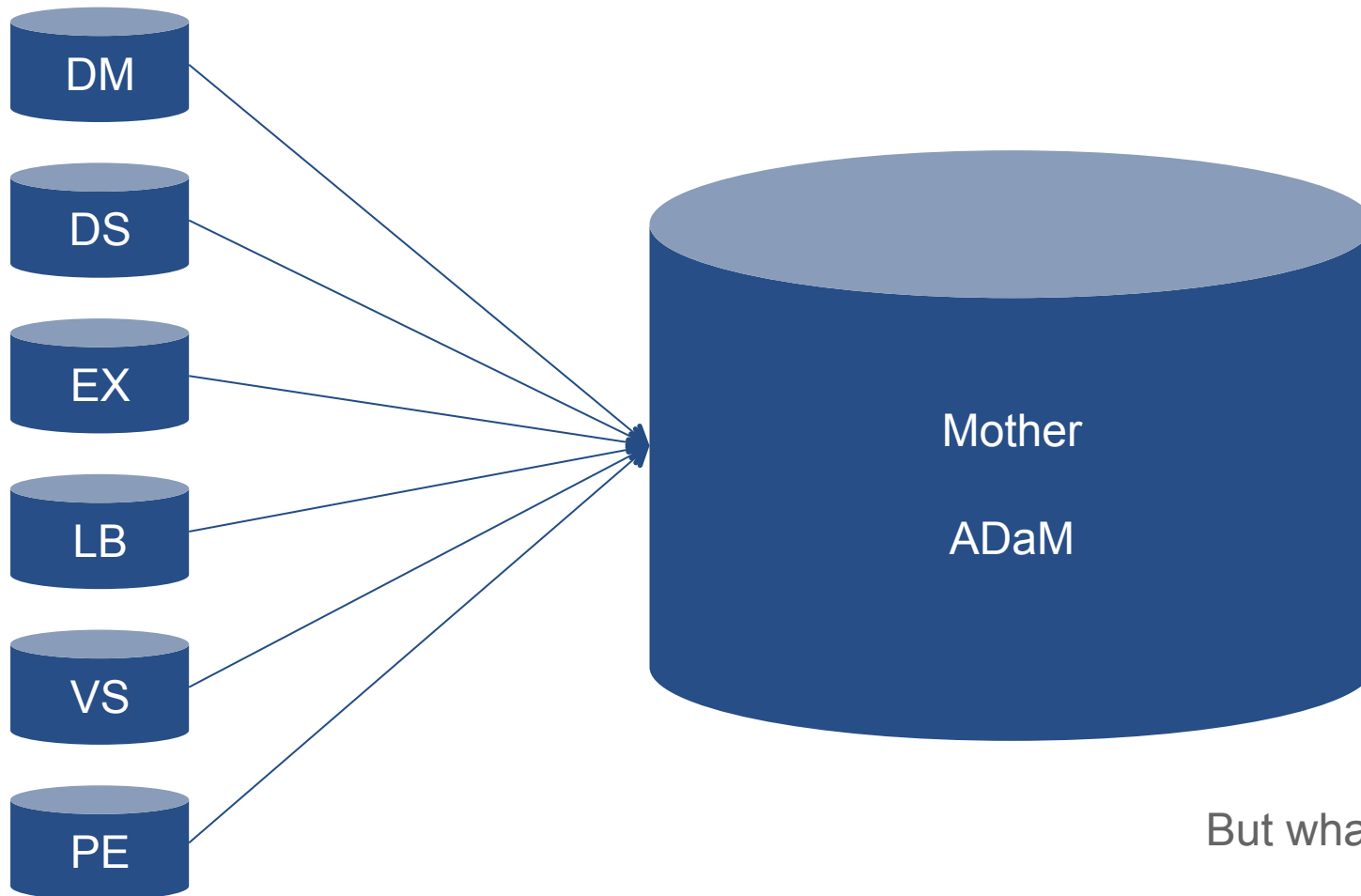


So why do we keep stumbling?





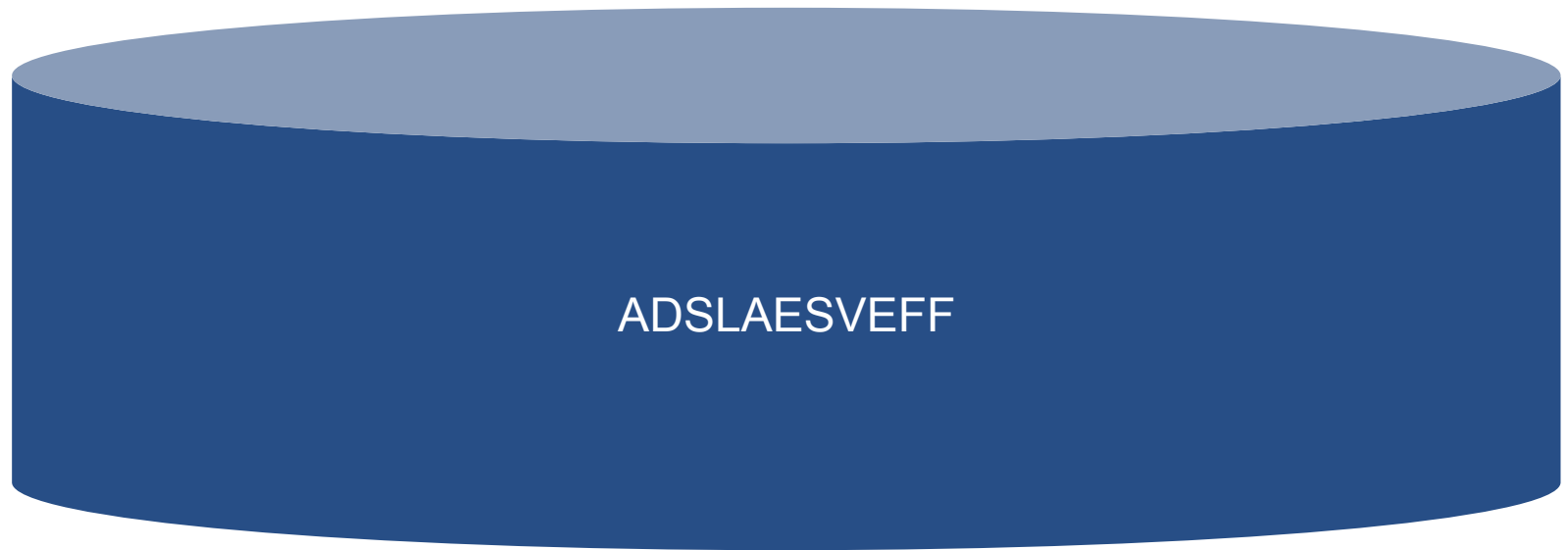
We can only afford one ADaM dataset



But what about ADSL?



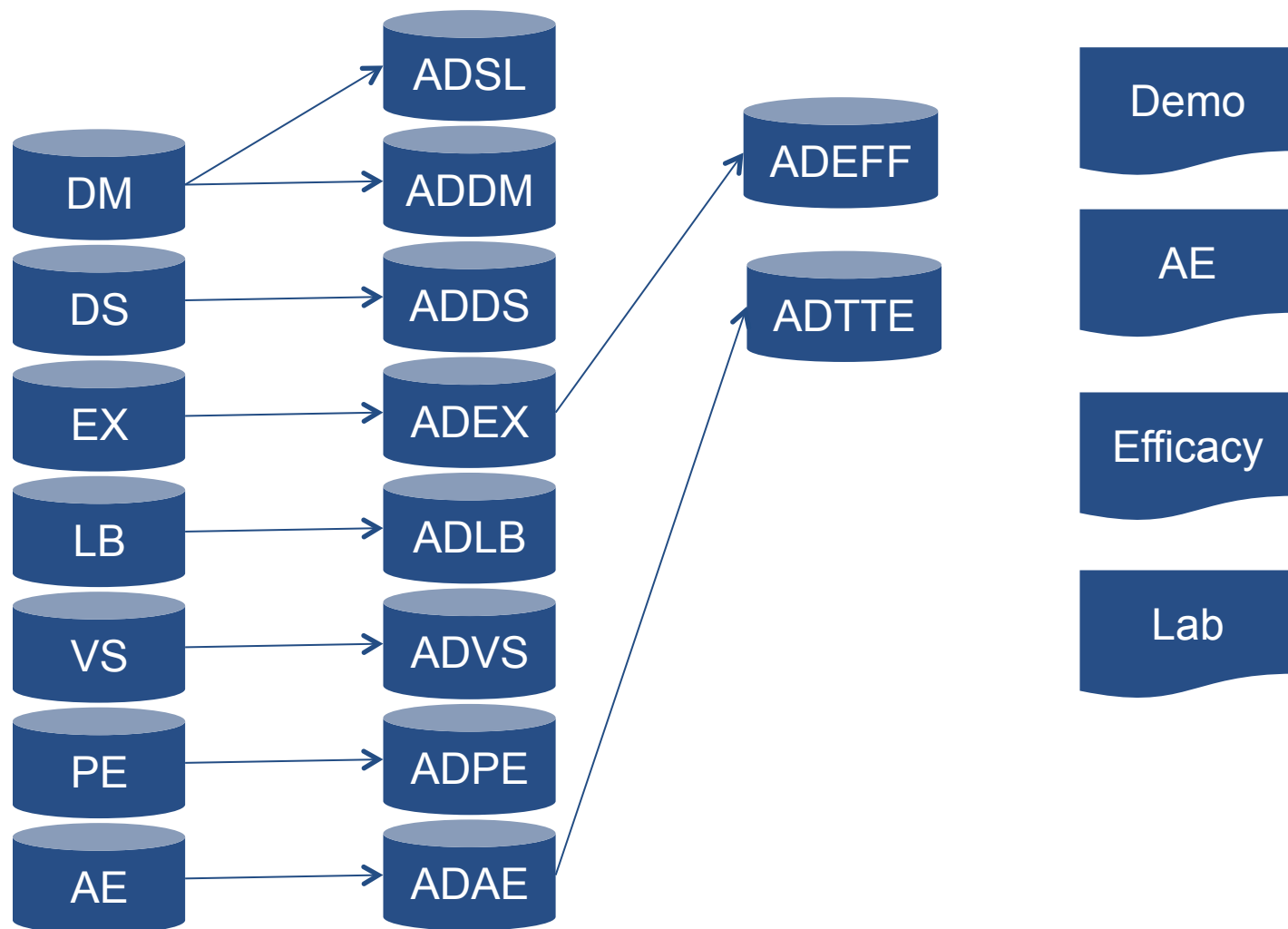
Can everything go into ADSL?

one dataset. Please!

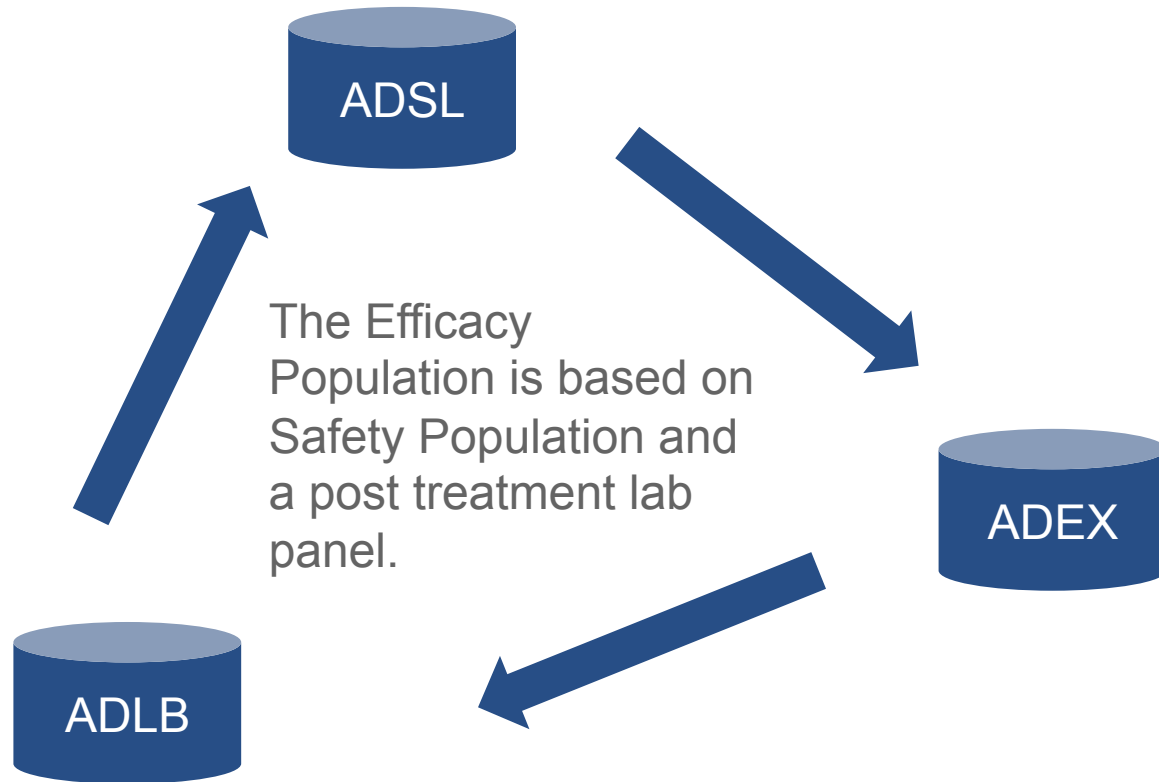


Does Everything in SDTM have to go into ADaM?



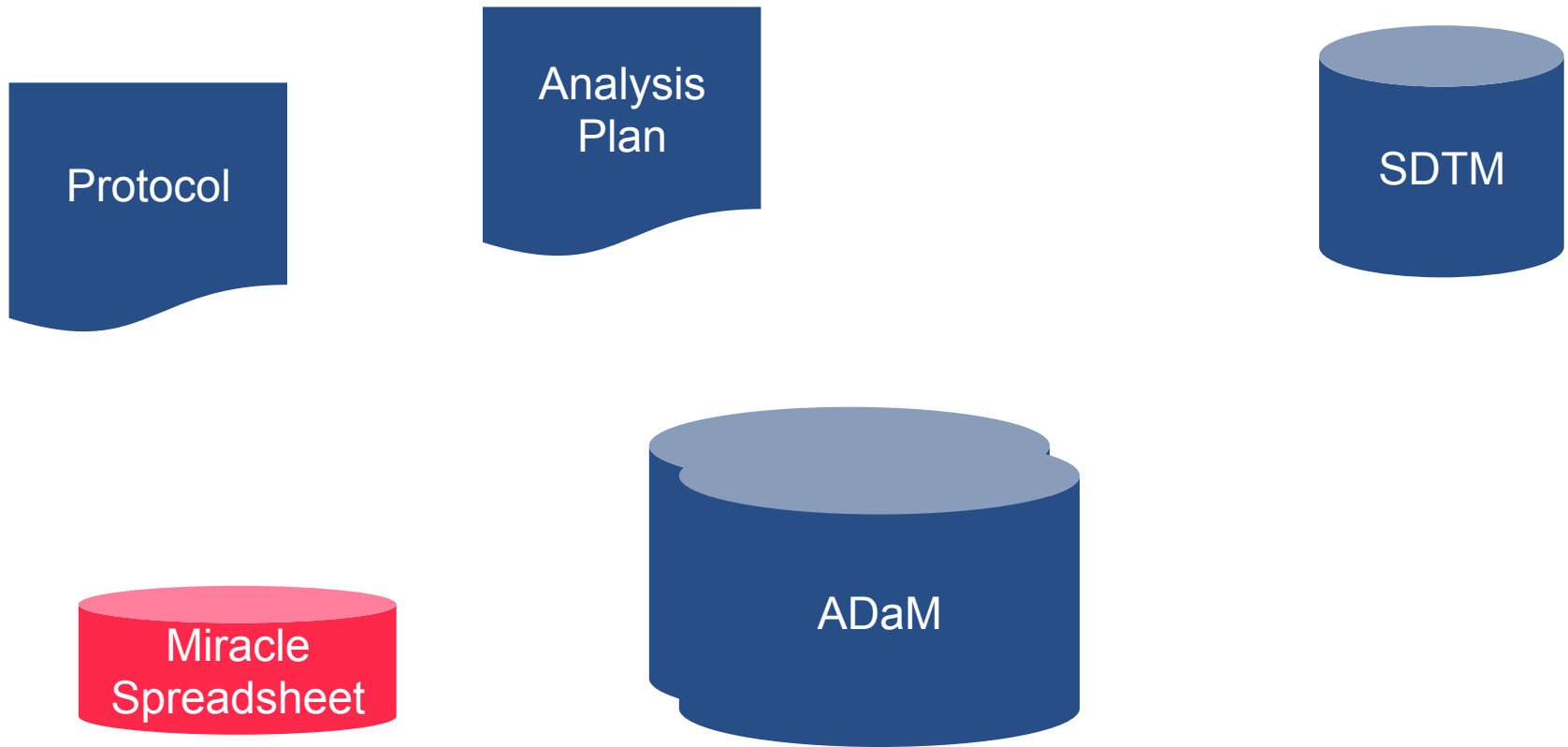


ADSL must be the first dataset created



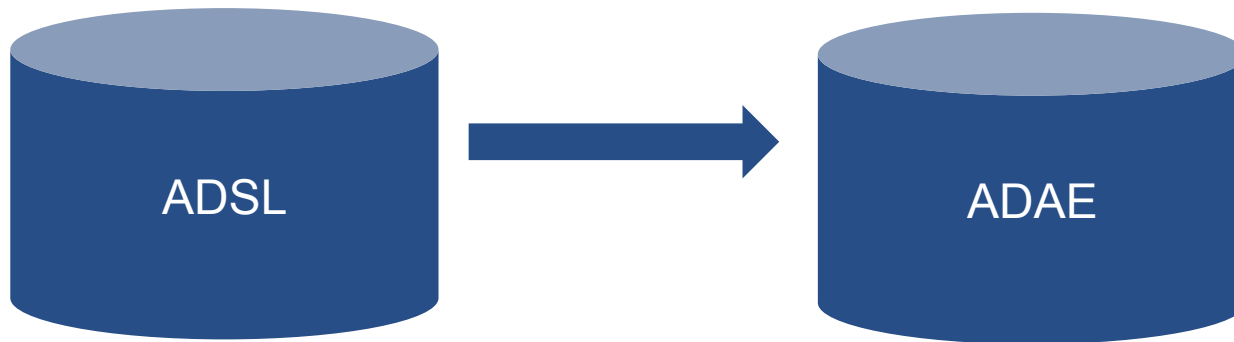


Can I use an Excel spreadsheet for ADaM source data?





You can't use ADaM to generate ADaM, right?





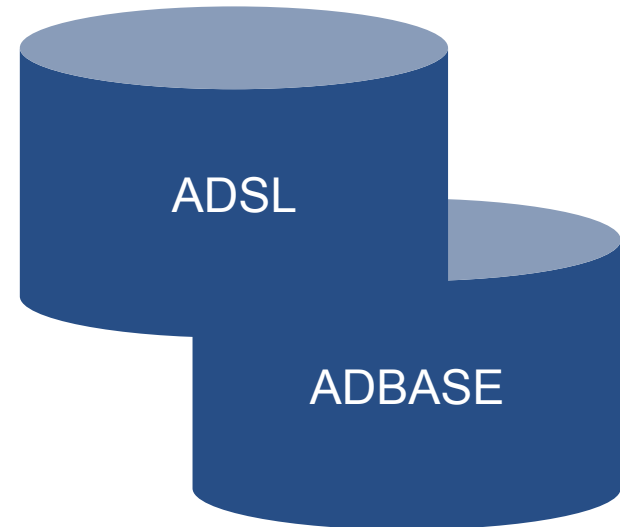
Every variable in ADSL goes into BDS, right?



Just because you can have 32,000 variables in a SAS dataset doesn't mean you should!

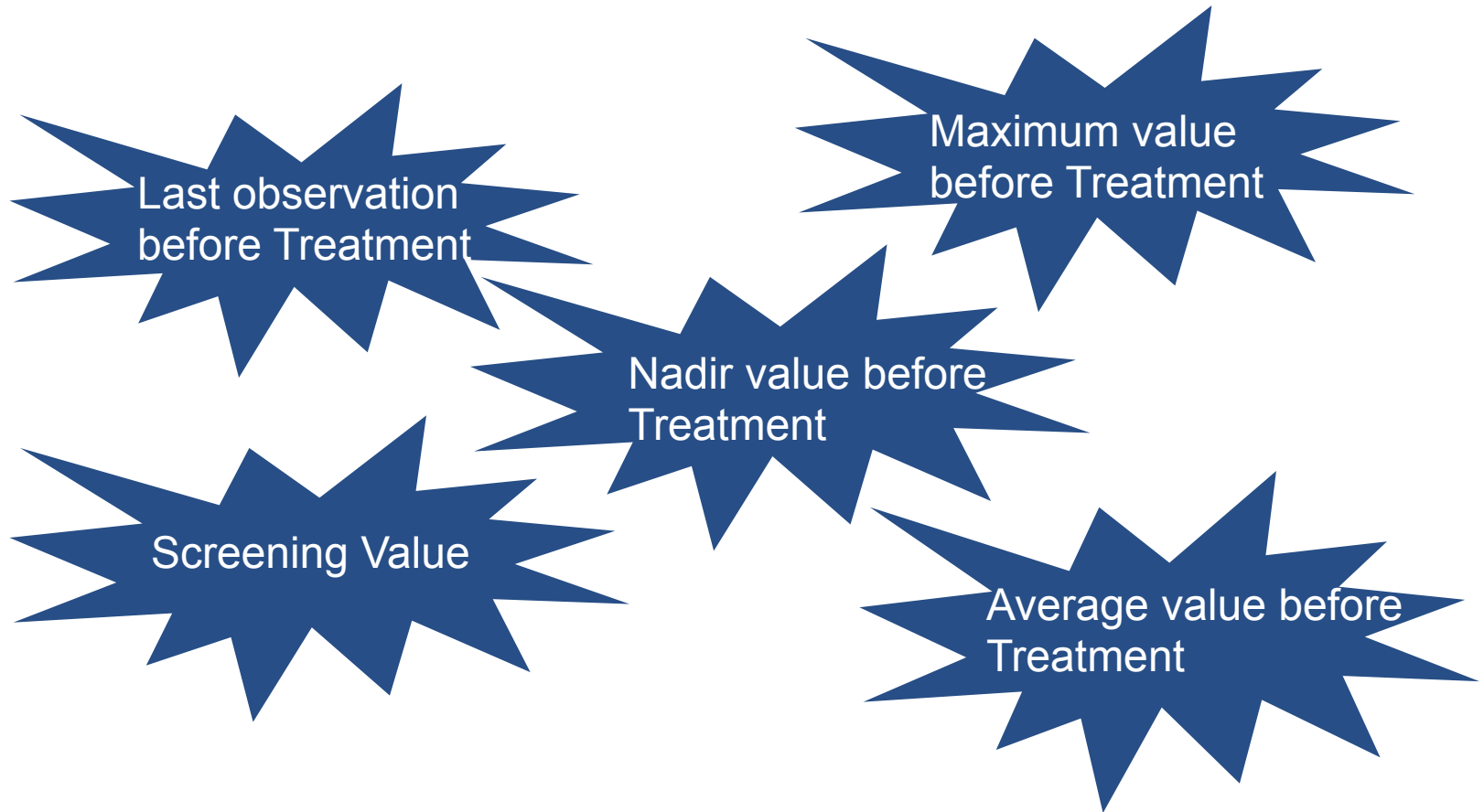


It's easier to add to ADSL than create a new BDS
