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


# INDIVIDUALITY




Diversity – varying traits and behaviors contribute to survival

Trekkers support each other while navigating through tough terrains




Helps teams navigate high-pressure situations more effectively

# ACKNOWLEDGING LIMITATIONS




Learning to accept that one may not always be the fastest or the strongest
