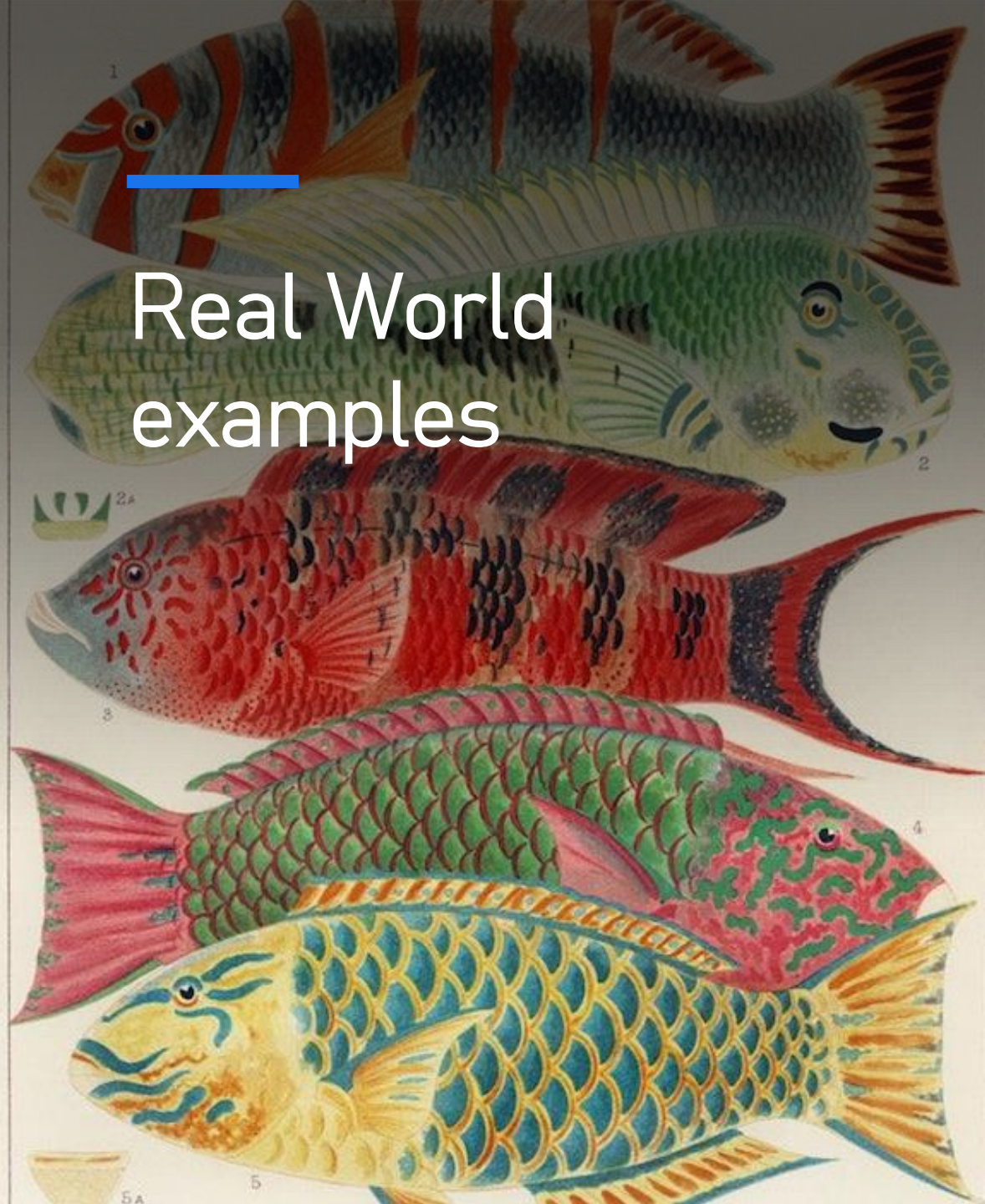

Two phase III open label clinical trials

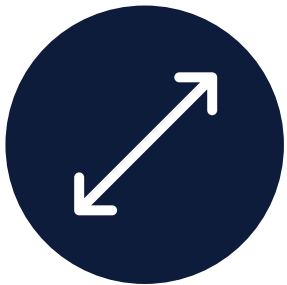
Core study

- 1200+ patients
- Up to 2 years participation time
- Two database locks

Extension study

- 900+ patients
- Up to 5 years participation time
- Core study patients can rollover into Extension after 1-year
- Rollovers start extension at Month 13
- Two database locks plus interim data cuts

Cross-functional Dynamics

Main considerations:

- Define all the words!
- Keep an open mind.
- The only “dumb question” is one not asked.

Importance for the collaboration:

- Come prepared, but stay flexible
- If it doesn't work the first or third time...
...keep at it!
- It's okay to say, “I don't know.”

Best Practices



Leverage data standards (CDISC / CDASH, company defined)



Keep the dialogue open



If talking early isn't an option, *talk even more often.*



Curiosity enriches the discussion
